We're building a new pedestrian crossing on West Street in Pukekohe

Kia ora,

We are building a new pedestrian crossing to improve safety and connectivity around West Street in Pukekohe. Work will take place between 27 July and 7 August 2026 during the day and overnight. This work is part of the Franklin Target Rate Programme.

Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we will notify you.

Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:

Where	Between numbers 76 and 95 West Street, Pukekohe
When	- Between 27 July and 7 August 2026 both during the day and overnight as below: - Dayworks: 9am to 4pm - Nightworks: 8pm to 5am
What we're doing	- New pedestrian refuge crossing - New signage - New line markings - New streetlights
How it may impact you	- On-street parking will be limited during works. You may need to either park on your property or on a side road and walk to your property. - Works will create noise and vibration; we'll do our best to keep noise down. Noisy work will take place during the day hours.
How travel is affected	- Lanes on West Road will be reduced - Detours will be in place at night to redirect traffic around the work site (see detour map/maps below). - Traffic controllers will be on site to assist you around the work site. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions.
